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The End of the Line in Little Creek



Buckingham Branch No. 2, an EMD GP16, was built in November 1950 as Seaboard Air Line 1732, a GP7 with the frame number 5070-3. Later it served as Seaboard Coast Line 912, Atlanta & West Point 4976, Seaboard System 4976, and CSX 1857. By midday on February 17, 2026, it had finished its chores and sat on the north end of the ex-PRR yard in Little Creek in the greater Norfolk area with the Chesapeake Bay at its back. While the Buckingham Branch is the operator, the line's owner is Canonic Atlantic Company, which filed with the STB on February 4 to abandon the 2.3-mile operation. Read about it in this High Green!
